Apr 22 (Fri) – Jul 3 (Sun), 2022

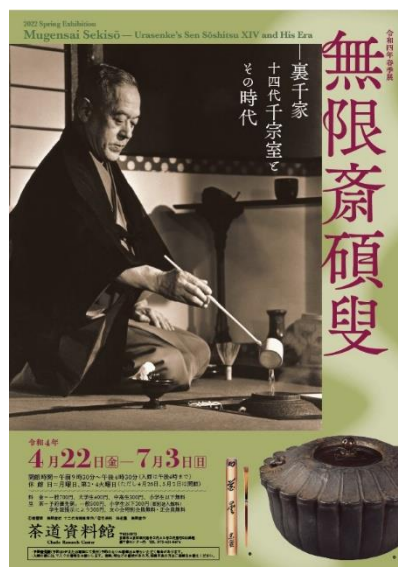
Cautionary note: Depending upon the Coronavirus situation, alterations in the schedule could occur.

Urasenke's fourteenth-generation iemoto, Mugensai (Tantansai, 1893-1964) is known for his energetic efforts, through to the last years of his

life, to disseminate knowledge and understanding of chadō both within and outside Japan. His establishment of the Tankōkai organization for followers of Urasenke chadō might be considered as his most impactful accomplishment,

Mugensai actively visited places near and far, working hard to set forth the iemoto's guiding principles and to standardize the basic Urasenke chadō temae procedures and etiquette, and transmit its correct style throughout the country. This work of his laid the organizational foundation for Urasenke chadō as it exists today.

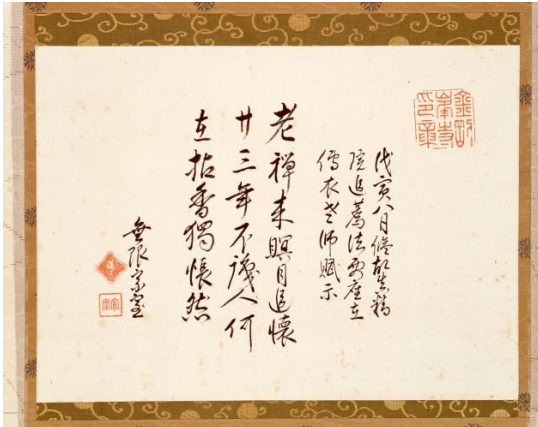
